I am writing to advise you that I'm in receipt your letter and plans, that you had courier to my office on December 6, 2004.

Having reviewed your material I have and the community has serious questions and concerns with your objectives planned for December 2004.

What type of site preparation are you continuing with? With respect to the storing of the batch plant on site unassembled, what does this entail? You also indicated that salt would be delivered to the premises, how will this be delivered, and what deliver times and the frequency will the salt be delivered? What safety and transportation measures have you implemented with trucks entering the facility for the pick-up and drop-off of salt? The community and myself are demanding and expect some answers to the questions and concerns raised above.

Area residents are very irate and frustrated at the way your company and the occupants (Toronto Redi-Mix/Draglram Salt) have handled this project, with informing the community of your proposed use and future intentions of this property.

The community has already distributed flyers and contacted various departments at the City of Toronto, expressing their adamant objection to any type of cement batching/salt storing facility at this location and requesting the City of Toronto to intervene on their behalf.
