We copied you on an e-mail reply from New Toronto Good Neighbours to Domenic Suppa of Toronto Redi-Mix.

Mr. Suppa suggested that Toronto Redi-Mix meet with concerned neighbours.

We believe the best forum for this meeting would be a public meeting with you, Toronto Redi-Mix, the New Toronto Community, and some of the staff from the city departments like planning, building, traffic, and environment who would be able to explain the impacts of the Toronto Redi-Mix/Draxlam Salt plans to the community.

We would appreciate it if you would work with Toronto Redi-Mix to ensure everyone in your ward has an opportunity to come out and hear their plan and ask questions.  
Would it be possible to do a bulk mailing to every home in Ward 6?

Our group would like to meet with you prior to meeting with Toronto Redi-Mix. We require clarification on your position on the issue of the appropriate industrial use for these lands. It will be good to talk through the issues and concerns.

Dan Caine invited you to meet with us last night, Wednesday, December 1, however we understand that you were in an late Council session.

Please let us know when would be a good time to meet with the members of our association.
