Hi Domenic,

I left you a voice-mail on Thursday, November 25th advising you that after viewing your facilities, I had even more serious concerns than we had discussed previously. I also invited you to contact me if you wanted to discuss your plans and the issues. Thank you for responding.

The members of our neighbourhood association think that having a meeting is an excellent idea. However, we believe that it should be a public meeting held in the evening, and not one held by invitation.

I have copied Councillor Mark Grimes and his Constituency Assistant, Barry Peters on this e-mail, because they would know the process for a public meeting and how to communicate it to the people in their constituency.

Our suggestion is that Councillor Grimes could update his web-site to announce the date and time of the meeting, and we would be willing to post it on ours. Toronto Redi-Mix could put signs on the 207 New Toronto Street property where they are visible from the side streets off Birmingham and along New Toronto Street.

Usually for a public meeting a notice is placed in the local paper.

This way you will be able to inform a significantly larger number of the people in New Toronto that will be impacted by your planned facilities.

Please let us know the date, time and venue.
